

The following scholarships are available for students registered to attend Prince of Peace Catholic High School next fall in grades 10, 11 or 12. The scholarships will be awarded to students who complete and return the attached application by **April 21, 2023**. Scholarship recipients will be selected by an independent scholarship selection committee of Prince of Peace parishioners. Upperclassmen can receive only one scholarship (unless there are insufficient applicants, in which case, students are eligible to receive more than one).

#### ▶ DOROTHY J. BENISHEK PRATT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP ▶\$725

The Dorothy J. Benishek Pratt Memorial Scholarship was established in 2006 in memory of Dorothy J. Benishek Pratt, who passed away March 2, 2005. Dorothy and her husband Harry belonged to Prince of Peace Parish. Dorothy was an English teacher in Clinton and enjoyed poetry and travel. The scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12.

### > FRED BENISHEK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP >> \$725

The Fred Benishek Memorial Scholarship was established in 2006 by a bequest of Dorothy J. Benishek Pratt in memory of her first husband, Fred Benishek, who died in 1966. The scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12.

#### MARY JUIST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP \$\$350

The Mary Juist Memorial Scholarship was established in 2013. Mary was a 1942 graduate of St. Mary's High School. She was an avid supporter of the Irish and loved to watch her grandchildren compete. Mary could be found sitting just inside the gym at Central Catholic Auditorium offering a smile and hello to everyone as they entered. This scholarship will be given each year to a Prince of Peace high school student.

# GEORGE MCANDREWS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP \$\rightarrow\$\$650

The George McAndrews Family Scholarship was established in 2015 by George McAndrews as a way to thank his parents for the Catholic education he received. George attended St. Mary's Elementary School and went on to graduate from St. Mary's High School in 1953. He was a member of the 1953 Iowa State Basketball Championship Team. George's commitment to Catholic education extends to his own children who attended Catholic schools.

# > THOMAS & PEGGY MCANDREWS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP >> \$800

The Thomas & Peggy McAndrews Family Scholarship was established in 2015 by Tom McAndrews in appreciation for the Catholic education he received at St. Mary's for 12 years. Tom graduated in 1954 and was a member of the 1953 Iowa State Basketball Championship Team.

The 1953 Iowa State Boys Basketball Championship Team Scholarship has been established by George and Tom McAndrews to honor the accomplishments and spirit associated with that historic championship.

## > EDWIN & EVELYN MICHL FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP >> 1,350

The Edwin & Evelyn Michl Family Scholarship was established in 2013 by the family of Edwin and Evelyn. Edwin and Evelyn Michl raised 12 children of their own and 4 children who lost their parents. While living in Clinton, the Michl children attended St. Mary's Elementary and High Schools. The two oldest graduated from St. Mary's High School before the family moved to Illinois. Donations came in from Edwin and Evelyn's children, but Evelyn herself contributed much of the scholarship funds stating, "I wanted to put this money to work right away because I thought families could use the help." This scholarship will be given each year to a Prince of Peace Catholic High school student.


The Nancy L. Peart Scholarship was established in 2022 to thank and recognize the contributions of Mrs. Nancy Peart. A 1969 graduate of St. Mary's High School, Nancy served as the principal of Prince of Peace from 2000 until 2021. The recipient of this scholarship should be a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12 who demonstrates an appreciation for Catholic education and lives Christian values and leadership in their daily life.

### > HARRY J. PRATT ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP >>\$450

The Harry J. Pratt Endowed Scholarship was founded in 2006 in memory of Harry J. Pratt, who passed away March 20, 2005. Harry was a believer in and supporter of Catholic education. His son is a graduate of St. Mary's High School. Harry and his wife, Dorothy belonged to Prince of Peace Parish. The Harry J. Pratt Scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12.

# > PAUL & CHRISTY ROTH SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP >> \$650

The Paul & Christy Roth Service Scholarship was established in 2010 through funds donated by family and friends of Christy, who passed away on August 28, 2009. Christy had a strong belief in service to her community, church, and school. Christy's husband, Paul Roth passed away on January 30, 2012, and shared Christy's philosophy of service to others. Paul was a 1979 graduate of St. Mary's High school and was involved in Irish Boosters, Knights of Columbus, Make-A-Wish, United Way, and many other organizations. The Paul and Christy Roth Service Scholarship serves as a memorial of Paul and Christy's service to our school, a challenge to others to serve, and is a celebration of students who will carry forth the value of service to others. This scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace student going into 12th grade.





## > ROBERT SHANNON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP >> \$600

The Robert Shannon Memorial Scholarship has been established by Robert's older brother, John Shannon (SMHS 1962), family and friends. John wanted to do something that would keep Robert's memory alive. Robert Shannon graduated from Clinton High School in 1968, was drafted and sent to Vietnam in 1969. On April 30, 1970, Robert received fatal injuries after subjecting himself to enemy fire as he rushed from his foxhole to trap insurgents, saving the lives of others. After his death, Robert was awarded the Silver Star, Bronze Star, Purple Heart, and Good Conduct Medal. By establishing this scholarship in the Prince of Peace School Foundation, Robert's selfless acts of heroism will be recognized.

# > LYMAN & ULLAINEE WAREHAM SCHOLARSHIP >> \$4,650

The Lyman & Ullainee Wareham Scholarship was established in 1992 through funds donated on the occasion of Ullainee's 80th birthday by family and friends. Both Lyman and Ullainee were 1930 graduates of St. Mary's High School and were able to continue their educations through the generosity of others. This scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12.

### ) JAMES L HILGENDORF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP )>\$250

The James L. Hilgendorf Memorial Scholarship was established in 2021 in memory of James L. Hilgendorf, who passed away June 25, 2021. Jim was a 1953 graduate of Saint Mary's High School. Jim and his wife Marlene, active members of Prince of Peace Parish, have always been strong supporters of Catholic education. They sent all four of their children to Catholic schools in Clinton. This scholarship will be given each year to a Prince of Peace high school student.

#### VERNON H. WITT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP \$\rightarrow\$\$450

The Vernon H. Witt Memorial Scholarship was established in 2007 by the family of Mr. Witt, who passed away June 23, 2003. Vernon was a tremendous supporter of Catholic education and worked very hard to see to it that all nine of his children could attend Catholic schools. He felt honored that his grandchildren enjoyed this same privilege. This scholarship will be awarded to a Prince of Peace Catholic High School student entering grades 10, 11 or 12.
