PARISH PICKS ARCHITECT

Jesus Christ, Prince of Peace Parish has selected Renaissance Design Group (RDG) with offices in Omaha and Des Moines, to develop the master architectural plan for its vision of a new church, community center and education facility. Joseph Lang, a partner with the RDG, will be the chief architect for the project. RDG will consult regularly with the parish throughout the development of the master plan. Part of the master plan development phase of the project will include the evaluation of possible sites for the new parish plant.

The decision to hire the architect to develop a master plan came from the January 19-21, 1996 parish-wide Strategic Planning Meeting which formed to address the factors of building maintenance, need for upgraded facilities, and two priests to serve 2,300 parish families.
