CLASS REUNIONS

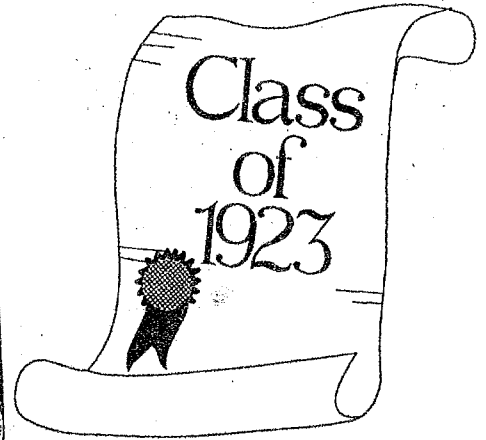
The St. Mary's Class of 1934 had their 60-year reunion on August 28th. It began with 4:00 pm Mass then a dinner at the Frontier.

John J. Lingle

When John Lingle died July 23, 1994, not only did I lose a good friend, so did the Clinton area residents and the Alumni Association.

When I returned to Clinton in 1970, John was a teacher and an assistant coach at St. Mary's High School. He was one of many who helped me settle comfortably into my new position as Clinton Herald sports editor.

John graduated from St. Mary's in 1956. He had been a freshman on the 1953 St. Mary's Iowa State Championship basketball team and earned 13 varsity letters in several sports before his graduation. He was a two-year all-conference basketball selection, a three-year all-conference football selection and an honorable mention all-state team member.

He attended Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska, before transferring to St. Ambrose College, Davenport, where he received a bachelor of arts degree. While at St. Ambrose he earned four varsity basketball letters and two track monograms. In 1990 he was inducted into the St. Ambrose Athletic Hall of Fame.

As basketball coach for 23 years (1968-1991) at his Alma Mater St. Mary's and Mater Dei, John set an all-time Iowa high school record of 308 wins in 1991. He took two Class A State Championships in 1975 and 1977 with a fourth place finish in 1978. He was twice named Coach of the Year and coached two Iowa High School All-Star Teams in 1981 and 1988. He coached many fine teams and athletes in several sports. In 1991 John became head basketball coach at Mount St. Clare College where he fulfilled his dream of coaching at the college level.

John Lingle will be remembered by many for his friendship, dedication and courage. When I think of all he was able to do for so many youngsters, for so many years, for our school and for the city of Clinton - his pride in those youngsters and his hometown - it is easy to understand why he was such a great man. For his helpfulness and spirit toward everyone, John will always be remembered.
