Greetings Alumni and Friends,



#### **News in our Schools**

The 1993-94 school year was packed with Irish pride. Noteworthy, was Mater Dei High School's first trip to the Iowa State Basketball Tournament since the merger of Mount St. Clare Academy and St. Mary's High School in 1981. Let's review some of the many highlights which occurred this year:

- \* Boys Cross-Country were Big East Conference Champions.
- \* Girls Volleyball team soared to a terrific 19-6 record.
- \* The Iowa High School Athletic Association distinguished the Cross-Country and Volleyball teams for academic excellence (grade point averages were 3.5 and 3.4, respectively).
- \* Girls coach Deb Dingmon Lind (MSCA'70) and boys coach John Riggins were both named "Big East Coach of the Year".
- \* 1994 Boys State Basketball Tournament crowds in Des Moines saw the Irish win the State Championship Runner-Up Trophy and the State Class IA Sportsmanship Award.
- \* Seven Speech students qualified for State Competition earning the highest score of "1", hosted a local radio (KROS) show and performed a dinner-theatre of <a href="The-Glass Menagerie">The Glass Menagerie</a>.
- \* The Visiting Artists Association was so impressed with our students' creative writing talents that they convinced Language Arts teacher Lee Schillinger, to compile <u>Inspirations: An Anthology</u> (several booklets are still available at \$5 each).
- \* Five Trinity Elementary students won regional awards in the National Radiant Peace Foundation Essay Contest and several art productions traveled with the Mississippi Trail Art Exhibit.
- \* Deb Strayer (MD'94) won first place in the 1994 High School Writing Contest for her essay "My View on Violence" (copy available upon request).


- \* Mrs. Georgene Krogman, second grade teacher at Trinity Elementary, received the Distinguished Service to Catholic Education Award from the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) in Anaheim, California.
- \* Marlys Lyons, Trinity third grade teacher, wife of Patrick (SM'80) was named "Young Educator of the Year".
- \* Leslie Kaup (MD'95), daughter of Peter and Mary (SM'67), was named first YWCA "High School Woman of Action".

Along with all the extras, our students still concentrate on academics, with emphasis on Advanced Placement Calculus and Accelerated Science. Of the 23 graduates in 1994, 22 have selected their college, 16 had GPA's of 3.0 or greater, 17 received scholarships (11 being major awards such as Presidential, Regents, etc.), 20 participated in one or more sport, 11 were National Honor Society members and over half of the Class of 1994 served in the Parish as lectors, eucharistic ministers, children liturgies assistants, or youth group ministry.

Twice in basketball and five times in any sport, the "school on the hill" took runner-up honors in State Tournament action. The Irish won cage titles in 1953, 1975, 1977 and were second in 1965. In baseball, the Irish claimed second in 1960 and first in 1963, and a state track title in 1959. Mater Dei's volleyball team swept three straight championships in 1981, 1982 and 1983. And finally, the Irish were twice runner-up in cross-country, as St. Mary's in 1975 and as Mater Dei in 1991.
